DRIVING DIRECTIONS

From the North:

1. take I-15 South
2. take exit 304 to merge onto 1-80 toward Cheyenne
3. take exit 129 for Foothill Dr./Parleys Way
4. Merge onto UT-186 West /Foothill Dr.
5. Take Foothill Dr. to 1300 South
6. Turn right at 1300 South
7. Continue to 2400 East on 1300 South

From the South

1. take 1-15 North
2. take exit 298 for Belt Route/I-215 East
3. Merge onto I-215 East
4. Take the state Hwy 186 W exit toward Foothill Dr.
5. Merge onto UT-186 /Foothill Dr.
6. Take Foothill Dr. to 1300 South
7. Turn right at 1300 South
8. Continue to 2400 East on 1300 South

From within the valley

1. Find the intersection of 1300 East and Foothill Dr. which is approximately 2220 East at that point.
2. Turn East and go up the hill past Larkin Sunset Mortuary to the Monument Park Stake Center at 1320 South Wasatch Drive (which is 2400 East).
